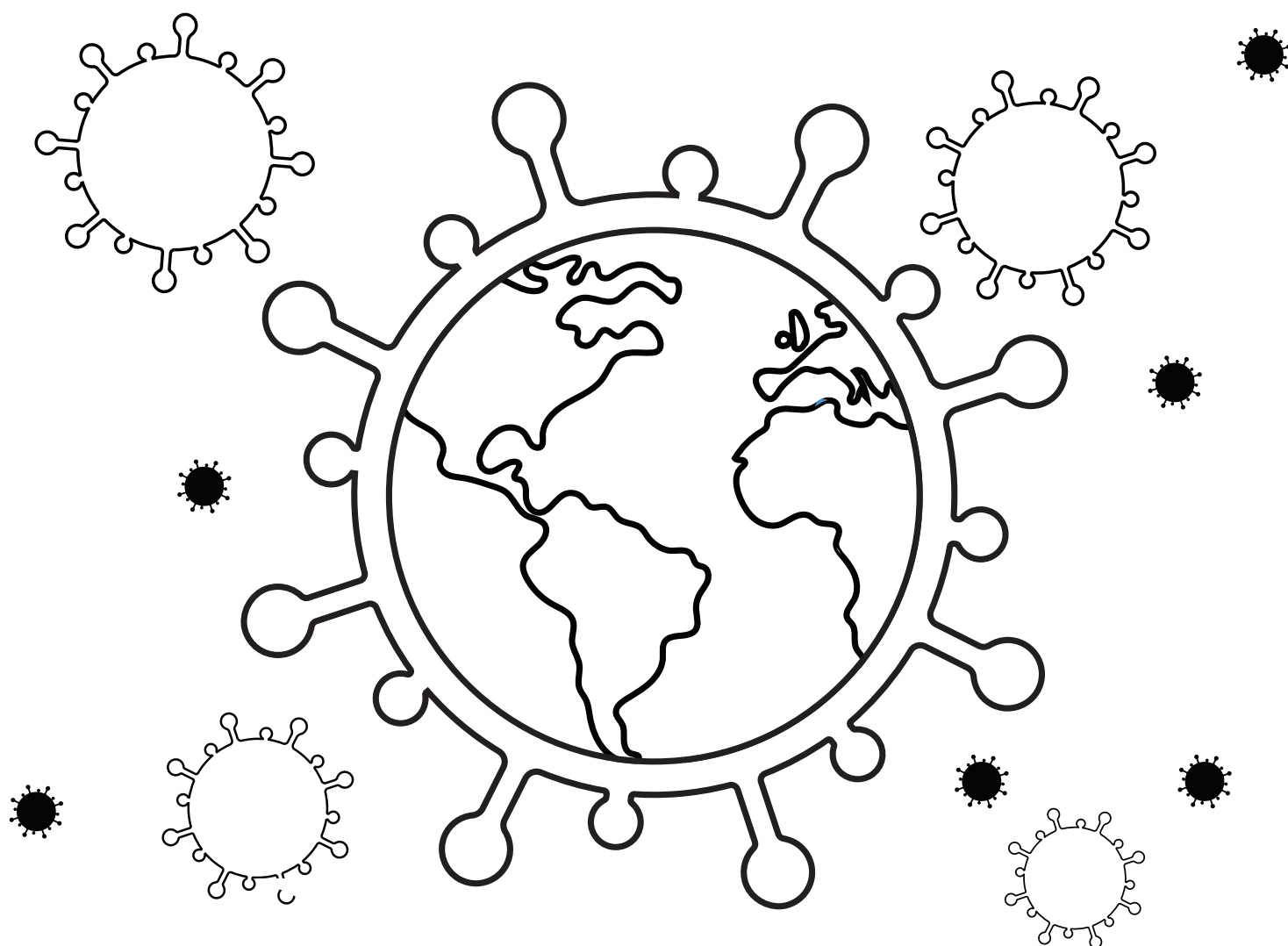

TALKED WITH HIS FRIENDS

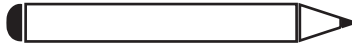
Once when Jesus was praying in private and His disciples were with Him, He asked them, "Who do the crowds say I am?" - Luke 9:18

(Read Matthew 6:25-34)

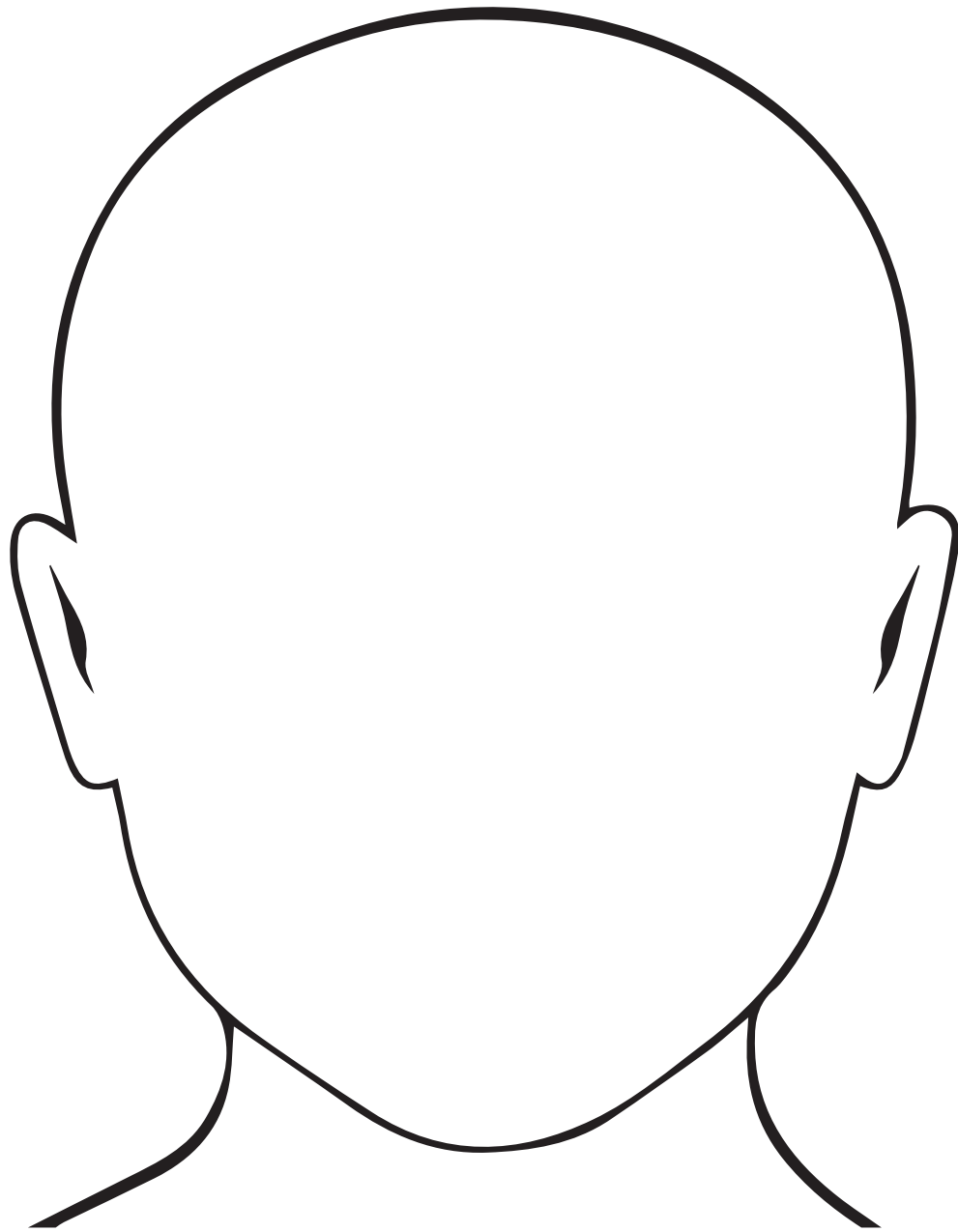
WHEN YOU FEEL STRESSED OUT

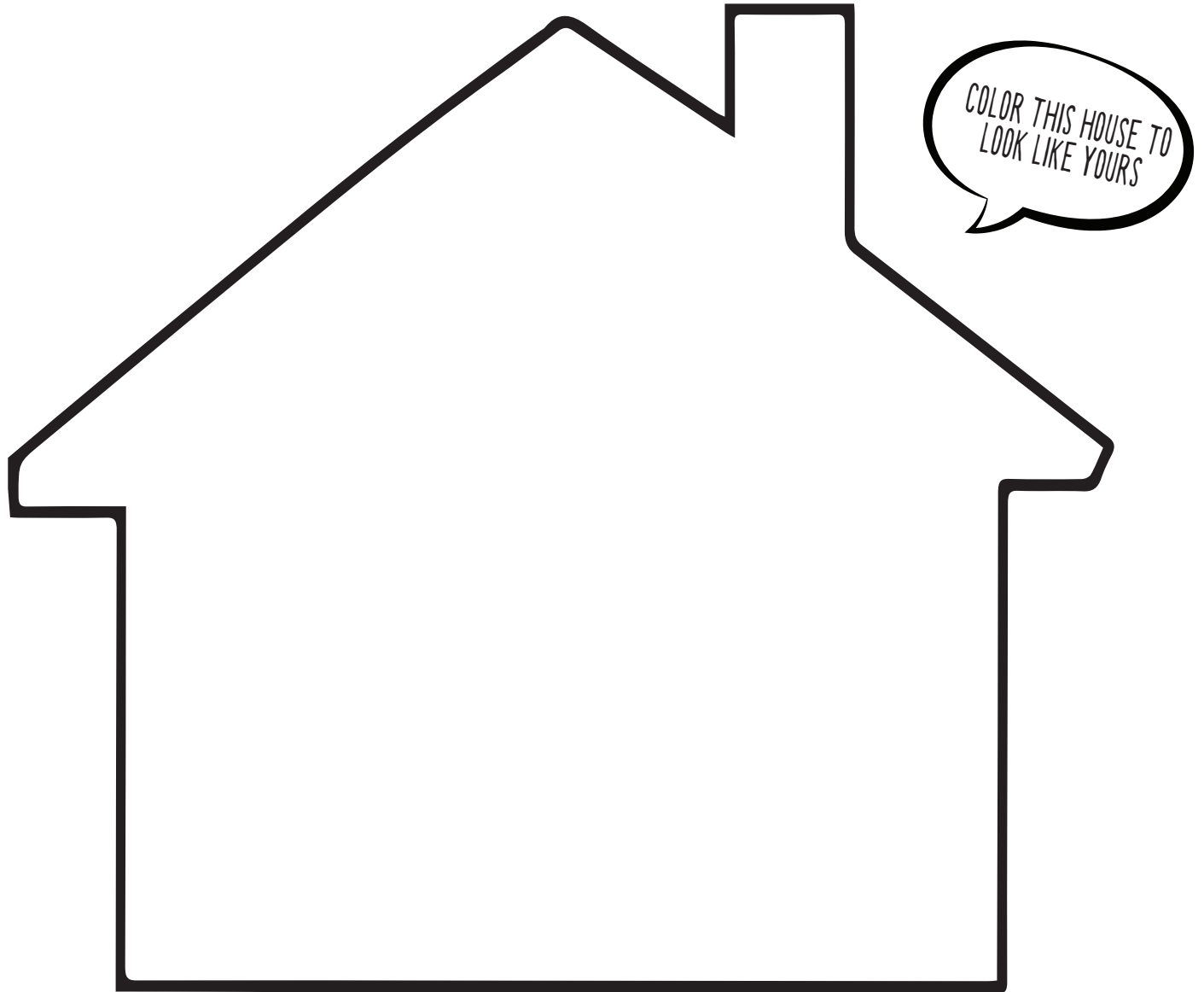


Psalm 119:105 says, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."

PROTECT YOUR SPIRIT

Finally, **be strong in the Lord** and in His mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes...Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the **gospel of peace**. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the **sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God**. And **pray** in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. **Ephesians 6:10-18**

But You, Lord, are a shield around me, my glory, the One who lifts my head high. **Psalm 3:3**



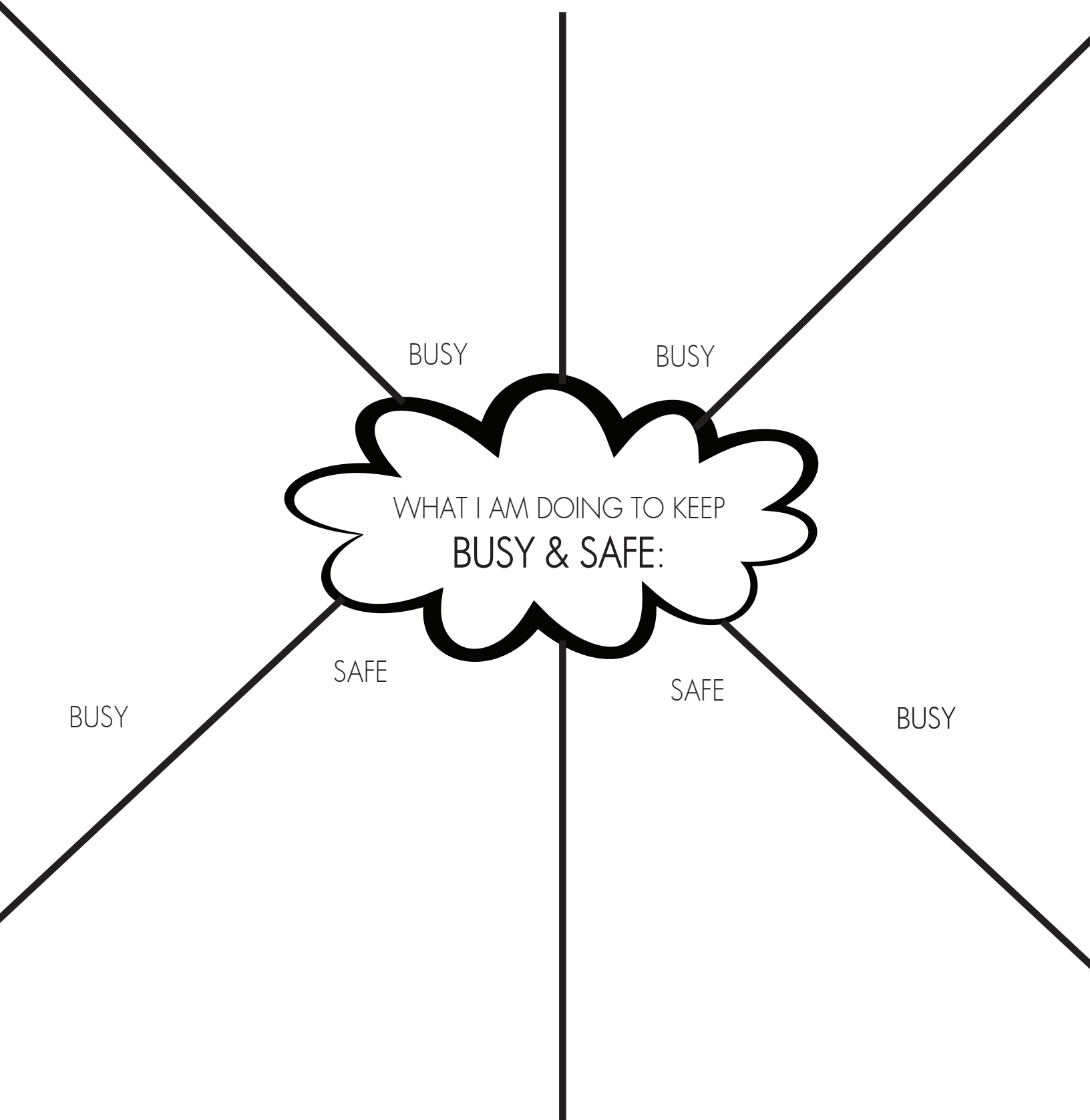
PROTECT YOUR BODY

- **Wash your hands** for at least 20 seconds with soap and water.
- **Don't touch** your eyes, nose, or mouth, especially if you haven't washed your hands.
- Regularly clean and disinfect surfaces and objects you touch a lot.
- **Cover your mouth and nose** with a tissue if you sneeze or cough, then throw it out. If you don't have a tissue, **sneeze or cough into your elbow**, not your hands.
- Wear a **face mask** if you go out.
- **Social Distance** (stay 6ft away from other people) if you have to go out.
- Stay safe at **home!**

IF I BELIEVE...

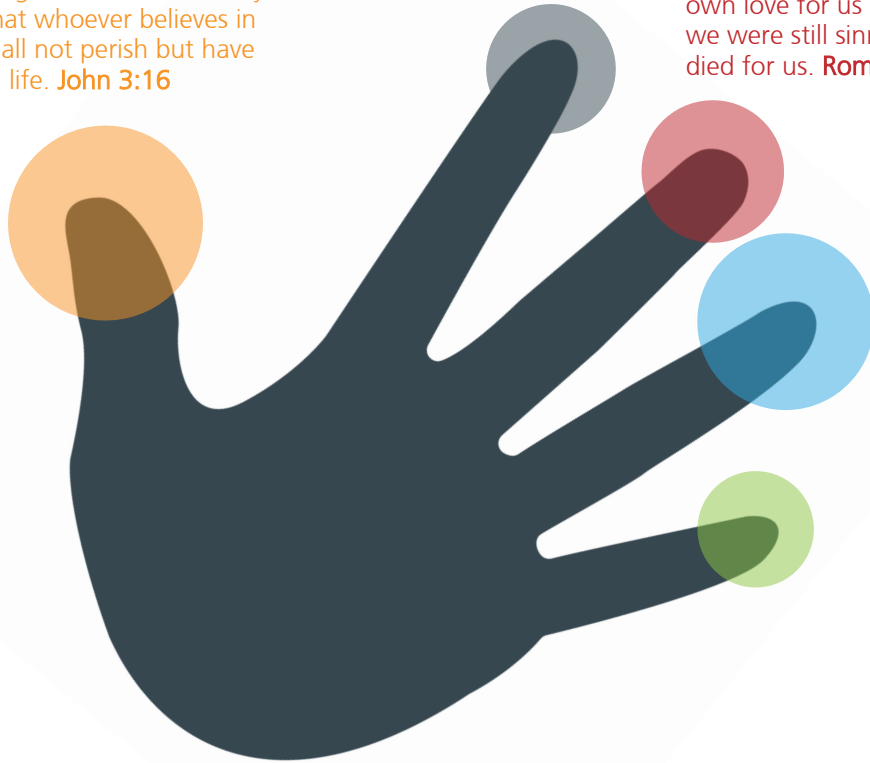
If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. **Romans 10:9**

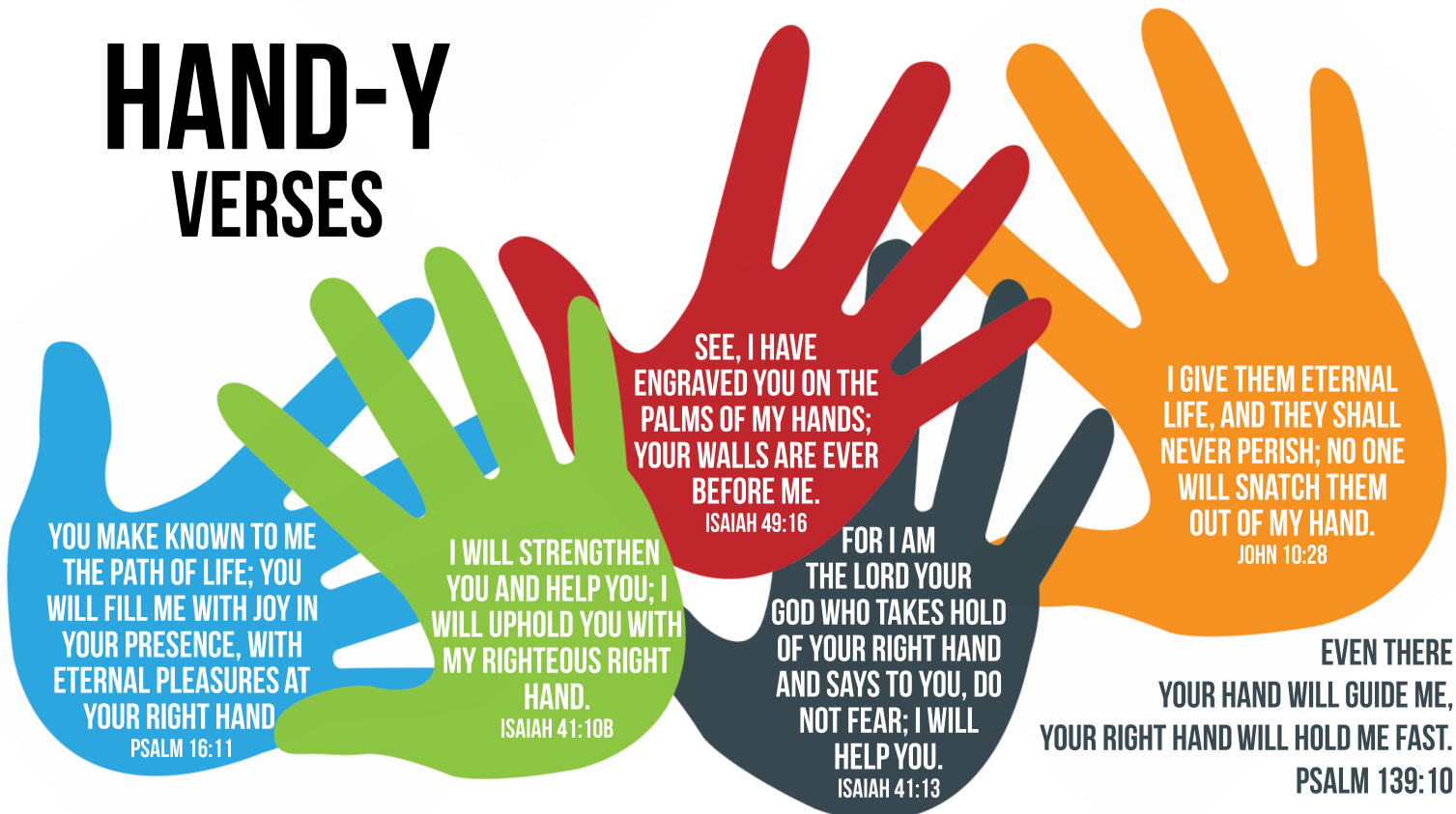

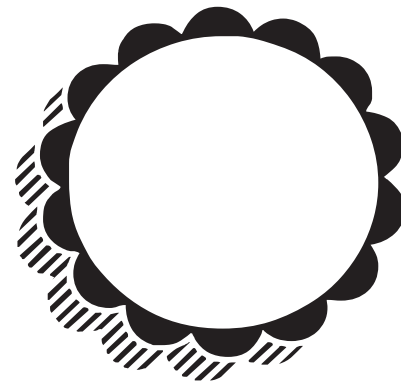
